

DE&I UPDATE

We're rapidly approaching the end of the 2022 Gregorian calendar year used in most countries, but did you know that not all cultures celebrate New Year's on January 1? Below is a list of some different New Year celebrations:

- Chinese New Year (January 22, 2023): Also known as the Spring Festival or Lunar New Year, Chinese New Year signifies the beginning of the spring harvest season. Colorful dragons and lantern displays can be seen around the world on this day.
- Ra's as-Sabah al-Hijrīyah (July 18. 2023): Ra's as-Sabah al-Hijrīyah, or Islamic New year, marks the first day of Muharram, the first month of the Muslim Calendar. It celebrates the emigration of Prophet Mohammed from Mecca to Medina, known as Hijra.
- Rosh Hashanah (September 15-17, 2023): Rosh Hashanah is a two-day holiday celebrated by those of the Jewish religion to commemorate the end of the seven days of Creation from the Book of Genesis. The festival includes rituals that are both performed with fanfare and with quiet introspection.
- Diwali (November 12, 2023): Diwali, the Festival of Lights, is celebrated by Hindu, Sikhs, and Jains the world over. However for Marwari and Gujarati communities in North India, Diwali marks the start of their new year.
