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



INFORMATION



In response to the continuing rise of fentanyl-related overdoses, Rec and Parks has partnered with ADAMH and COMPDRUG to install Narcan boxes in all of our community centers and other facilities including Tyson Cultural Arts Center, Franklin Park Adventure Center and McKnight Outdoor Education Center. We had a pilot program in 2021 to run a trial in the Opportunity Centers and have decided it should be available to ALL neighborhoods in the interest of consistency and inclusion. COMPDRUG will be coming out to the Community Centers' All Staff meeting on March 22. The 30-minute training will start at noon and at the end of the training, Narcan doses will be offered to each person interested.

- EVERYONE in the Department is invited to participate in this life-saving training.
- Please understand you are NOT REQUIRED to administer Narcan (even after the training), but if you are comfortable and wish to do so it would be your choice.
- A two-dose kit is available to anyone who requests it after this training (for your own purposes).
- If you have an interest in attending, contact Sherry (5-8568 or shbooth@columbus.gov) to ensure we have the space and materials available. The location will be determined the week of the training.

CPR/AED/First Aid Training
