### SPOTLIGHT ON CONSERVATION

#### PROTECTING AND CONSERVING NATURAL AREAS

Did you know that the department has 20 designated nature preserves, which means that over 2,000 acres of land are being preserved for future generations? Each nature preserve features a variety of habitat types, from the forests and streams of Kiwanis Riverway Park to the wetlands of Hamilton Wetlands. These habitats support an abundance of plants and wildlife, some of which are state or federally listed as endangered, threatened or species of concern. <u>Learn more about our 20 nature preserves</u>.

Protections for nature preserves were added to City code in 2022. Having nature preserves in City code increases the protection of these areas by tightening prohibitions of activities and impacts that can occur in those locations—from constructing infrastructure to off-trail hiking. It also sets the process for how future land could be considered for such designation. The nature preserve code also formally acknowledged the Advisory Council that provides recommendations to the director and Commission with respect to the management of the nature preserves.
