CITY OF COLUMBUS AND JUNETEENTH

On June 19, 2020, Mayor Andrew J. Ginther signed a proclamation officially recognizing June 19 as Juneteenth at the city government level. Just under a year later, on June 17, 2021, <u>Mayor Ginther announced</u> that Juneteenth would become an official, paid holiday for all full-time City of Columbus employees beginning in June 2022.

Last year, all City employees were given an additional paid holiday to use at their discretion and in coordination with their supervisors. This year, the City is closed June 19 in observance of the holiday. As you enjoy having the day off on June 19, take some time to reflect on the origin of Juneteenth, the background of which you can find below.

ONGOING AND UPCOMING CELEBRATIONS

- **Pride Month-June:** A month dedicated to honoring the movement for LGBTQ+ rights and celebrating the LGBTQ+ culture and community. It began after the Stonewall riots, a series of gay liberation protests in 1969, and has since spread outside of the United States.
- Caribbean-American Heritage Month-June: Celebrates the achievements and contributions of Caribbean immigrants and their descendants living in the United States.
- **Juneteenth-June 19:** Commemorates the emancipation of enslaved African Americans. The name comes from combining "June" and "nineteenth." It is celebrated on the anniversary of the order, issued on June 19, 1865, proclaiming freedom for slaves in Texas.


