#### **Important Dates**

- International Day of the World's Indigenous People (8/9): Observed annually to raise awareness and protect the rights of the world's indigenous population. This event also recognizes the achievements and contributions that indigenous people make to improve world issues. It was first pronounced by the United Nations General Assembly in December 1994.
- Women's Equality Day (8/26): Commemorates the 1920 adoption of the Nineteenth Amendment to the United States Constitution, which prohibits the states and the federal government from denying the right to vote to citizens of the United States on the basis of sex. It was first celebrated in 1971.

# New Emergency Notification System Goes Into Effect Soon... Make Sure You're Ready!

Our department will soon be switching to a new emergency notification system that will help us to better communicate internally. The new system will help increase the speed and efficiency with which we can notify staff members of events such as weather delays, closings and other alerts. To ensure you receive notifications via specific emails or phone numbers, you will need to update that information by **Tuesday, Aug. 22**. A test email will be sent out the following day to ensure there were no issues during the process.

You might be wondering how to update your contact information, in which case all you need to do is follow the steps outlined below:

- Log into your **Dayforce** account
- Click on "Profile"
- Under "About Me," in the contact information, click
   "Edit" (AKA the "pencil icon")
- Update your personal information as needed
- While changing your Phone Numbers and Email Addresses, make sure to categorize as "Work" or "Personal" under "Type"
- Click "Submit"

• **7 a.m.:** Registration, number pickup and health screenings begin


• 9:15 a.m.: Line up at the start line
