NEW PROCESS FOR BUILDING MAINTENANCE REQUESTS IMPROVES SERVICE, EFFICIENCY

The CAPRA process has helped us take a deeper look at our processes and service levels. A new way to submit building maintenance requests will improve service for staff and increase efficiency for the Building Maintenance team. Benefits of the new system include an easier way to submit requests without logging in, custom reporting capabilities, email updates on your requests and more.


SCHEDULE YOUR FREE HEALTH SCREENING




