SPOTLIGHT ON CONSERVATION

GRANT FUNDS FIRST-OF-ITS-KIND WETLAND PROJECT

We are thrilled to announce we've received an \$850,000 grant that will be used to establish a 12-acre wetland habitat within the northern expanse of Three Creeks Park. This is the first time the department has worked on a project of this nature.

Often coined as "nature's kidneys," wetlands play a pivotal role in filtering pollutants from flowing water. In addition to cleaning water, wetlands serve as vital habitats for numerous aquatic and terrestrial plants and animals.

The grant is through the H2Ohio Grant Program. Launched in 2019, this program aims to enhance water quality throughout Ohio.

As December arrives, winter weather is just around the corner. Whether you love it or hate it, it's crucial to know what steps to take when the weather turns challenging.

- Internal Severe Weather Guidelines: These guidelines explain how department facilities operate during inclement weather, including when staff should report to work. They also detail how we will notify you if we decide to postpone opening or close completely, utilizing the Everbridge emergency notification system.
- External Inclement Weather Guidelines: These guidelines ensure the health, safety and well-being of participants, volunteers and staff during inclement weather by outlining the operation of department facilities.

Both guidelines are available in the Policies and Procedures Manual on the intranet.

To ensure we're prepared for winter weather, we will be conducting a test of the Everbridge system. To make sure you receive the notifications:

- Confirm that your contact information is up-to-date in Dayforce by Tuesday, Dec. 12. <u>View this step-by-step guide on how to make those updates</u>.
- Watch for a test of the Everbridge system on Wednesday, Dec.13. You will receive an email, phone call and/or text message based on the contact information you've listed in Dayforce.
 - Please note: Once you have confirmed receipt/answered a message (email, text message or phone call), the system will note that you have received the notification and will stop messages through the other methods.

ADOPT A CENTER EVENTS KICK OFF THIS WEEK




