With this new team in place, it's crucial to know whom to reach out to for assistance. The Technology Team will oversee project management as well as handle a spectrum of responsibilities, such as:

- Handling new hardware requests (desktops/laptops, monitors, printers, headsets, webcams, flash drives and mobile devices)
- Managing new software requests, including Adobe Suite Software, Remote Access accounts and other tools enhancing daily work duties
- Providing training sessions to help staff with technology use, covering Microsoft Office applications (Outlook, Word, Excel, etc.), Remote Connectivity, WebEx and basic laptop usage
- Addressing connectivity issues and evaluating service quality, such as resolving bad Wi-Fi locations and slow speed
- Creating new network folders and facilitating access to existing folders on the P drive
- Overseeing the department's presence on the CBUS Intranet
- Managing cell phone ordering and setup

# IMPORTANT DAYFORCE SECURITY UPDATE - ENHANCED LOGIN METHOD

To further strengthen our defenses against fraud, the City is implementing a new security measure called Multifactor Authentication (MFA) for accessing Dayforce. Beginning Wednesday, Nov. 29, you will be required to provide two pieces of identification instead of just one when you log into Dayforce Employee Self Service or the mobile application. This extra layer of security is designed to prevent unauthorized access, strengthening the protection of your sensitive information.

#### What does MFA mean for you?

- **Enhanced security:** MFA adds an extra layer of protection by requiring two forms of identification, such as your password and a temporary code sent to your phone.
- **Ease of use:** The setup process is easy to enable; <u>review these instructions</u>. You can choose how to verify your identity in addition to your user ID and password, such as a text or phone call.
- **Peace of mind:** You can feel confident that your payroll information is well-protected, reducing the risk of unauthorized access and potential fraud.

### CHECK YOUR LIFE INSURANCE BENEFICIARY DESIGNATION

If you're enrolled in the City's life insurance plan and haven't recently reviewed your beneficiaries, please do so as soon as possible. If you pass away unexpectedly without designating a beneficiary, your life insurance payout could become part of your estate. This means the funds go into a legal process called probate. This could delay your loved ones from getting the financial compensation they need to move forward.

If you have not done so within the last year, <u>log into Dayforce</u> to review and update your beneficiary designation. <u>View this video for instructions</u>.


### LAST CALL: 2024 HDHP OPEN ENROLLMENT

The Annual High Deductible Health Plan (HDHP) Open Enrollment period for the 2024 plan year ends Thursday, Nov. 30. This is your opportunity to enroll in the High Deductible Health Plan with a Health Savings Account.

Please take a moment to review the details of the High Deductible Health Plan, Pharmacy, Dental, Vision and Basic Life programming in the packet mailed to your home. You will need to complete your enrollment in Dayforce no later than Nov. 30, 2023. <u>Learn more about this benefit</u>.


If you do not wish to enroll in the HDHP with a Health Savings Account, no action is required. Open enrollment for the PPO plan is in February. You can update your elections for the PPO plan as well as pharmacy, dental, vision and basic life coverage at that time.
