### PAID FAMILY LEAVE: SUPPORTING STAFF WHO ARE CARING FOR A FAMILY MEMBER

The City of Columbus' new Paid Family Leave (PFL) benefit takes some of the burden off of caring for an ill family member or welcoming a new child into your home.

This new benefit offers you up to 12 weeks of paid leave at 100 percent of your regular wage. Eligible uses include the birth or adoption of a child or caring for a family member with a serious health condition as defined by the Family Medical Leave Act (FMLA)\*. All full-time employees are eligible for PFL the month after they're hired.

Read through the process to apply for PFL, and to understand what information you'll need to provide.


