FITNESS ROOM:

Dodge is a "Get Active" fitness center. The following are the membership fees: Ages 18-49: \$15.00/session or \$60/year. 50+ participants, \$10.00 a session or \$40 per year. Fees must be paid to the City of Columbus. To use the fitness room, children ages 14 to 17 must be accompanied by a paid parent or guardian.

INSURANCE SPONSERED PROGRAMS

Columbus Recreation and Parks offers Silver Sneakers, Silver & Fit, Active & Fit, Renew Active and One Pass insurance sponsored programs to eligible participants. Adult Fitness pass is included with each insurance sponsored programs.

DROP-IN SPORTS PASS:

Adult open play activities (badminton, Pickleball, volleyball, and open gym) are valid at any CRPD facility that offers Adult Open Play. The cost per session is \$10 (Winter, Spring, Summer, Fall), \$1 daily sports passes are available, you must have an account, be registered, and paid to participate! If you have any questions, please see the center staff!

LEISURE CARDS

Columbus Recreation & Parks Department requires all participants age 3 and up to have a leisure card at no cost. Please see front desk attendant to register for a leisure card. Leisure cards are scanned at the front counter. Leisure cards are good at ALL CRPD facilities!
