REGISTRATION POLICIES

- ◆ All programs with course numbers attached to them on the schedule can be registered for online. All others must be registered for in person. Payment price listed in the **Cost** column of the schedule may be paid for online with VISA, Mastercard or Discover card, or in person with VISA, Mastercard, Discover card, check or cash.
- ◆ Prices listed under the **fee** portion of the schedule must be paid in person with cash or check at the first class.

REFUND POLICY

- ◆ A 100% refund will be given only if you withdraw from a class before its starting date.
- ◆ If you withdraw prior to the second class a 50% refund will be given.
- ◆ No refund will be given after the second scheduled class.
- ◆ To obtain a refund for class costs, participant must inquire with Columbus Recreation staff at the office.
- ◆ Refunds will be mailed by the Columbus City Auditor to the participant mailing address in 6-8 weeks.
- ◆ **Note:** No account balances can be maintained on participants accounts.

Adult Open Sport Pass

This pass is \$10 per session and applies to any adult open sport activity (volleyball, pickleball, basketball and badminton). The pass will apply at any of the Columbus Recreation and Parks Department community centers.
