TRY EVENTS

This spring session, join us for Adaptive Golf, Wheelchair Softball, and Wheelchair Rugby Try It events! Whether you're trying a sport for the first time or looking to develop new skills, these events are a great way to get involved and have fun.

FITNESS CENTER

Our fitness staff will be operating out of the Fran Ryan Center. Any participant requiring hands-on assistance for transferring must bring a support person to assist.

Fitness Center passes are available to purchase by session or annually. Silver Sneakers, Silver & Fit, Renew Active, and other discounts/grants may be available to help defer costs.

INCLUSION SUPPORT

Our Inclusion Services team works closely with families to develop individualized accommodation plans that support campers with, but not limited to, Autism, ADHD, Down Syndrome, developmental and learning disabilities, physical disabilities, sensory challenges, and emotional challenges. We provide reasonable accommodations to ensure all campers can successfully participate in camp activities.

Please note: One-on-one staffing is not provided. However, campers are permitted to have a personal support person present onsite, pending the completion of a mandatory background check.

We are hiring for our Therapeutic Recreation summer day camps, which provide an inclusive environment for campers with disabilities, ages 6 to 21. These day camps focus on recreational activities that promote personal growth and social skills. The position has a pay rate of \$15/hour, and the camp runs from June 2 - Aug. 8 at Dodge Community Center and Franklin Park Adventure Center.
Applicants must be 18 or older.

It's a great opportunity for students in fields like special education or therapy, and it's a Monday-to-Friday position with no weekend work required!
