

#### **DROP-IN SPORTS PASS:**

Adult Open Play activities (Pickle ball, Soccer, Basketball, Etc....) are valid at any CRPD facility that offers Adult Play. The cost per session is \$10 (Winter, Spring, Fall1, Fall 2). Adults Must be registered for the activity, have a leisure card, and have an Adult Sports Pass for the current session. If you have any questions, please contact center.

#### CLASS REGISTRATION AND PARTICIPATION:

Class schedules, dates, and fees are subject to change. For the most up-to-date information, please call the center. Participants must be registered for all activities, **NO DROP INS. Youth ages 6 and under must be accompanied with an adult.** All participants must have a leisure card, which are free, and must be scanned at front desk at arrival. After program/class is over participants are required to leave.

#### **PLAY SCHOLARSHIP:**

Financial assistance is provided for school aged youth. Those that qualify and are under 18, registration must be done in person to receive PLAY Scholarship and can only be used within the <u>FIRST TWO</u>

<u>WEEKS OF THE SESSION OR BEFORE REGISTRATION ENDS FOR YOUTH SPORTS</u>

<u>LEAGUES.</u>

#### **REFUND POLICY:**

A 100% refund will be given only if participant withdraws from the program/class before the first class. If participant withdraws prior to the second class a 50% refund will be given. No refund will be given after the second class.
