PLAY SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The PLAY Scholarship Fund was created because the City of Columbus believes all kids deserve the chance to play regardless of ability to pay. Financially-challenged families with children 18 years and younger can apply for a PLAY scholarship for any fee-based program offered through Columbus Recreation and Parks Department. Proof of eligibility must be provided, including Copy of current Medicaid, CareSource or Molina insurance card; copy of current EPPICard; copy of the most recent federal income tax return (scale based upon HUD Section 8 guidelines).
