Managers and timekeepers: Mandatory in-person Dayforce training is launching mid-August and will run through September. This is a hands-on, personalized session using real-time data from your teams, so it's the perfect chance to sharpen your skills and ask questions.

## **TECH TIP: WINDOWS 11 UPGRADE STARTS SOON**

Heads up! The Department of Technology (DoT) is rolling out Windows 11 across the City. While you can start the upgrade on your own now, it will become mandatory starting in August.

Upgrade early to avoid delays and downtime! Here's how:

- 1. Type Software Center in the Start menu and open it.
- 2. Click Operating Systems, then "MSFT inplace upgrade Windows 11 24H2."
- 3. Hit Install, then Install again.

#### Tips:

- Start the upgrade at the end of your workday—it takes time.
- Save important files to your U drive before upgrading.
